Principles of gliopathology: rethinking astrocytic reactivity and challenging "inflammaging"

Alexei Verkhratsky is an internationally recognized scholar in the field of cellular neurophysiology. His research is concentrated on the **mechanisms of inter- and intracellular signalling in the CNS**, being especially focused on two main types of neural cells, on **neurons and neuroglia**.

Among other contributions, he authored a **pioneering hypothesis of astroglial atrophy and homeostatic failure as a mechanism of neurodegeneration**, **challenging the concept of «inflammaging»**.
